Irving Petersen Jr. age 76 of Waupaca, WI passed away on Monday, Sept. 12, 2005. Irv was born on February 4, 1929 in the Town of Farmington, Waupaca County and grew up in Waupaca's Third Ward, the son of Irving and Margaret Petersen.
