WILD ROSE, WISCONSIN Age 89 passed away on Wednesday, October 26, 2005 at her home in Wild Rose. She was born April 4, 1916 in Wautoma, WI; daughter of John and Sadie (Day) King. She graduated from Wautoma High School in 1932 and Waushara County Normal School in 1933. On January 26, 1935, Madeline married John G. Apps in Waukegan, IL. He preceded her in death on October 13, 1988. Madeline's occupations and locations were varied in her life – two neighborhood grocery stores in Superior, WI; Harrington's Shoe Store in Waupaca, WI; Kemper Insurance and Cotton Shops in Chicago, IL; Stern's Personnel in New York City, NY; and Roth's Department Store in Superior, WI.
