Raymond W. (RW) Haasch, age 93, of King, WI, formerly of Elm Grove, WI, passed away on Saturday, May 13th, 2006 at Wisconsin Veterans Home-Ainsworth Hall, King. He was born in Milwaukee on January 30, 1913, he was the son of the late William and Mary (Bies) Haasch. He married Jean Campbell on June 21, 1941 in Milwaukee. She preceded him in death on November 17, 1998. He was a graduate of Marquette University Engineering School ('36) and was a veteran of WWII at which time he served in the U.S. Navy from May 28, 1943 until January 16, 1946.
