James Jacob Schilleman, age 70, of King, WI, passed away Monday, January 1st, 2007 at the Wisconsin Veterans Home. He was born in New London, WI on February 7, 1936, the son of Harry and Edith (Hoha) Schilleman. James was a 1954 graduate of Washington High School, New London. He enlisted in the Army Reserves on February 7, 1953 and was honorably discharged as PFC on July 14, 1954. James enlisted in the U.S. Navy on July 20, 1954 and was honorably discharged as a Seaman on April 1, 1959. He served on the USS Uvalde in California, Alaska, and Japan.
