Dr. Kenney L. Willarson, Ret. USAF, age 75, of Waupaca, Wisconsin, passed away Tuesday, January 1st, 2008. Dr. Willarson was born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin on December 17, 1932, he was the son of the late Olivar B. and Annette R. (Kenney) Willarson. On April 25, 1959, he married Mercedes McCarthy in Braddock, Pennsylvania. Kenney was a 1950 graduate of Wauwatosa High School. He graduated from the Marquette University Dental School in 1956 and Tufts University Dental School-Boston in 1962. He served in the United States Air Force from 1955-1979. He and his family moved to Waupaca in 1978 and he was associated with the Schmidtke Dental Clinic in Iola and Amherst till 1988. He later worked for Dental Associates in Appleton for 5 years. He liked jazz and big band music and was an excellent clarinet and saxophone player.
