Marjorie H. Cook, age 95, of Wild Rose, WI, passed away Thursday, October 23rd, 2008 at Crystal River Nursing Home in Waupaca. She was born in Chicago, IL on July 8, 1913, the daughter of William and Rose (Floring) Clauss. For her sophomore year of high school, Marge attended Kemper Hall in Kenosha and graduated from Main Township High School near Des Plaines, IL. On February 9, 1935, Marge married Howard Cook in Chicago. He preceded her in death on October 13, 1998. In 1951, they moved to a farm in Wild Rose where they lived until 1995. Marge was a full time mother and farm wife. For several years she served as organist at the Wild Rose Presbyterian Church and member of the choir. Marge was a member of the Mount Morris Homemakers group, card clubs, and volunteered at school, church, and in the community. She enjoyed traveling and spending time with her family.
