Jeffery Raymond Volz age 66 of Scandinavia, WI passed away January 22, 2009, at St. Joseph's Hospital, Marshfield, WI. Jeff was born on October 29, 1942, in Jackson, MN, and raised in Lakefield, MN, by his parents, Gilbert Volz and Blanche Blankenburg Volz. He married Marleen Marie Herre on November 2, 1963, at St. Peter's Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac, WI. Jeff served in the Army from 1960 through 1963. He was a retiree of Canadian National Railroad, having been employed as a machinist for 35 years by the Soo Line/Wisconsin Central/Canadian National in North Fond du Lac, WI. Jeffery was a member and served as an usher at Immanuel Evangelical Lutheran Church in Waupaca, WI. He was a charter member and former president of the North Fond du Lac Optimist Club. In the most recent years, he was a member of the Scandinavia Booster Club and enjoyed Thursday morning Kaffe Klatsch with friends and neighbors.
