# Hubert Kenowski

**H**ubert Kenowski, age 85, of Weyauwega, WI, was set free March 14th, 2009 at Wisconsin Veterans Home in King, WI. He was born in the Town of Stockton, Portage County, Wisconsin on October 30, 1923, the son of Peter and Martha (Rzentkowski) Kenowski. Hubert lived and worked on his parent's farm in Amherst, WI until he was drafted in 1943. He fought in World War II in Italy. After serving his country honorably, he returned home in 1945. Hubert married Donna Hamelin on September 30, 1950 in Milwaukee. His various adventures included working on the Alaskan Highway, panning for gold, working as a lumberjack, and helping construct Stordock and Marden Halls at the Wisconsin Veterans Home in King. He bought a farm in 1962 where he was a welcoming host for his brothers and nephews for the hunting season. Hubert loved archery, country music, and played violin and harmonica.
