Lawrence *Larry* Allan Bertzyk, Jr, *Tiger* age 49, of Wild Rose, WI, passed away Wednesday, April 1st, 2009 at Theda Clark Regional Medical Center in Neenah. Larry was born on September 19, 1959 in Milwaukee, the son of Lawrence and Mary Bertzyk, Sr. He married Rosemary Helen Seifert on July 31, 1982 in Las Vegas, NV while both were serving in the US Marine Corps. Larry was baptized and confirmed in St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Wautoma where the family are current members. Larry attended Wautoma High School. He then served in the US Marine Corps from 1980-1984. After an Honorable Discharge he moved his family from California back to the Wautoma area and worked at Nelson Muffler. After moving to Rosholt, LBJ was employed as a maintenance technician from October 1988 to the present time at the Waupaca Foundry. In November of 1994, Larry and family purchased a hobby farm in Wild Rose. From a little boy on, Larry loved his animals.
