Jane Elizabeth McGlinch (Jane Elizabeth Halcott), age 90, of Waupaca, WI passed away May 16, 2011. At the time of her death she was surrounded by her loving family. Jane was born in Jackson, MI August 30th, 1920. After growing up in Jackson, Jane was the first female to enlist in the Army for World War II from Jackson County, MI. She served in England and France during the war. Jane married Charles Alexander McGlinch and had four daughters. Jane and her husband Charles moved to Waupaca in 1988 and lived here since. She is survived by her husband Charles McGlinch, brother Robert F.
