King, WI (formerly of Oshkosh, WI) Age 87 - died Thursday, March 22, 2012 at the Wisconsin Veterans Home in King, WI. He was born on August 16, 1924 in Oshkosh, WI, the son of Joseph and Helen Drexler.

Joseph is survived by his children: Marcia Krenzel of Lockport, IL, Annette Drexler of Oshkosh, Peter (Kathy) Drexler of Brownsville, Barbara (Tim) Schneider of New London, and Brian (Heidi) Drexler of Oshkosh.
