Charles M. “Chuck” Johnson, age 65 of Necedah, WI passed away at the Madison Veterans Hospital on Sunday, August 25, 2013.

Chuck was born in Edgerton, WI the son of Charles and Naomi. He was a 1966 graduate of Janesville High School, and worked for General Motors for 32 years.

Chuck was very proud to have served in the Army from Dec. 1966 to Feb. 1972. He attended Officer Candidate School before doing a tour in Korea in the Infantry.
