Roger J Stiebs, age 67, of Corvallis, OR formerly of Waupaca passed away on Saturday, May 3, 2014 in Corvallis. Roger was born in Waupaca on November 18, 1946, the son of Clarence and Marjorie (Nelson) Stiebs. He graduated from Waupaca High School and attended college at UW-Oshkosh, UW-Madison, Oregon State University and Linn-Benton Community College graduating with a degree in landscaping.
