### **M**ARION E. READER STEVENS POINT, WISCONSIN FORMERLY OF ALMOND

Age 92, peacefully passed away on Thursday, May 15, 2014 at her home in Stevens Point, WI. She was born January 20, 1922 in Madison, WI; daughter of Nicholas and Mary (Hron) Malas. Marion grew up in Madison and graduated from Center High School. After high school, she attended UW-Whitewater and graduated with a Bachelor of Education degree in May 1943. On October 3, 1946, Marion married Glen F. Reader at Guardian Angels Rectory in Almond. Together they shared 37 years of marriage before his passing on June 5, 1984.
