Trevalyn G. Hansen, age 87, formally of Waupaca, passed away peacefully on Monday, July 14, 2014 at her home in Pewaukee. 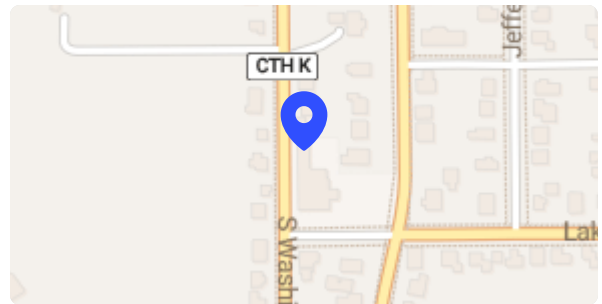

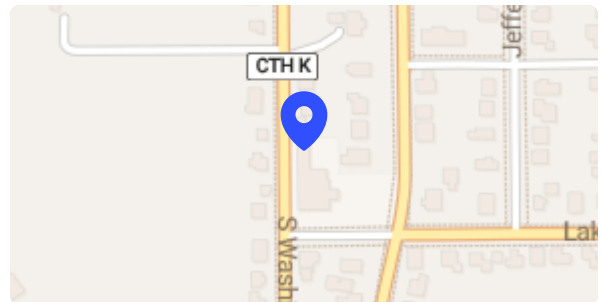
