DOROTHY E. PESKIE ALMOND, WISCONSIN

Age 93, passed away peacefully on Saturday, November 8, 2014 at Riverside Medical Center in Waupaca, WI. Dorothy was born on October 16, 1921 in the Town of Buena Vista, Portage Co., WI; daughter of Alfred and Edna (Boushley) Wanty. She attended Madley County School through the 8th grade and graduated from Amherst High School in 1939. On November 28, 1940, Dorothy married Donald T. 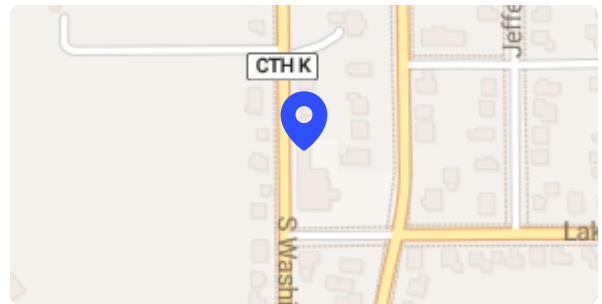

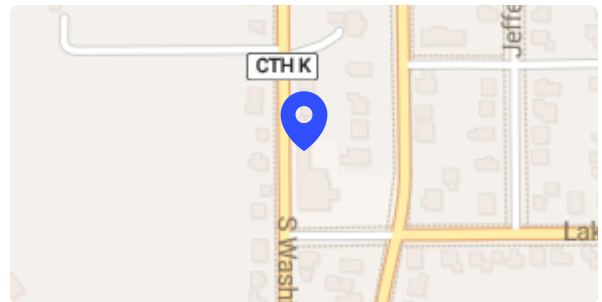
