Neal A. "Pinky" Boneck - age 78 - of Wild Rose, WI, formerly of Milwaukee - passed away on Wednesday, December 3, 2014 at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Madison, WI. He was born on October 3, 1936 in Milwaukee, WI, the son of Lloyd and Agnes (Schinkl) Boneck.

Neal is survived by his daughter: Kristine (James) Malchow of Waupaca, granddaughter: Jessica Boneck (Chauncy Nash) of Milwaukee, grandson: Jamesneal Malchow of Appleton, and brothers: Denny (Marilyn) Boneck of West Allis, Lloyd (Barb) Boneck of Manitowish Waters, and Gary (Arby) Boneck of Bullhead City, AZ.
