## **Andrew (Andy) Jacowski**

**A**ndrew (Andy) M. Jacowski, 89 of Almond passed away on Wednesday, November 16, 2016 at Saint Joseph's Hospital in Marshfield. He was born September 3, 1927 in the Town of Lanark, Portage Co., the son of the late Andrew and Regina (Wysocki) Jacowski. He attended Pickerel Lake grade school, Wausaukee High School, and graduated from Almond High School. Like many young men, during his era, Andy went to Milwaukee seeking work, while in Milwaukee he worked for Allis-Chalmers, Nash-Kelvinator and Standard Cab Co. Andy was a WWII Veteran serving his country in the United States Navy. On January 14, 1956, Andy married Audrey H. Mack at St. Stanislaus Catholic Church in Stevens Point. He worked the family farm until 1962 when he became a Rural Letter Carrier for the United States Postal Service for 34 years. Andy was also owner/broker of Big Hills Realty. He will be deeply missed by all of his family and friends.

Andy enjoyed remaining active in his sons farming operation, vegetable gardening, playing cards, and spending time conversing with his family and friends, especially the St. Maximilian Kolbe Breakfast Club. Andy had a deep love for playing and watching baseball, he played for many local teams, the Navy baseball team and the White Sox organization. Andy also coached the Lanark baseball team along with local little league teams. Andy enjoyed being an active member of the community with his participation in the Almond Rod and Gun Club, American Legion Post 339, Portage County Citizen's Groundwater Advisory Committee, and the Rural Letter Carriers Association.

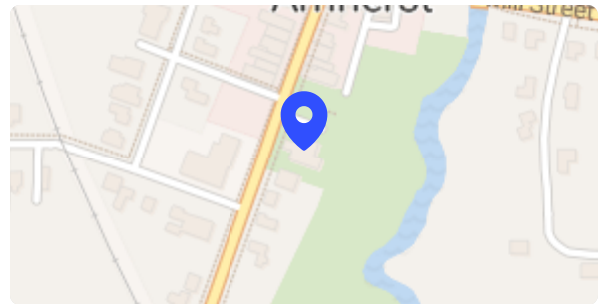

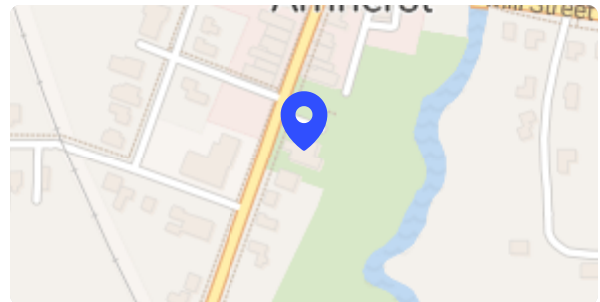
