LaVerne H. Kienert, age 91, of Waupaca, WI, passed away on Tuesday, November 29th, 2016 at Bethany Home. He was born in Waupaca, on June 26, 1925, a son of the late Walter and Edna (Grunwald) Kienert.

He married Avis Rasmussen on October 25, 1947 in Waupaca. She preceded him in death on March 11, 2015.

LaVerne served in the U.S. Navy during W.W. II. LaVerne was a long time member of the Immanuel Ev. Lutheran Church in Waupaca. He and Avis had owned and operated both the Rosa Theater in Waupaca and the former Highway 10 Outdoor Theater in Waupaca for 18 years.
