Godwin R. Voss, age 67, of Weyauwega, WI died February 24, 2017 at his residence. He was born May 27, 1949 in New London, WI to Richard and Fern (Jasman) Voss. While at a barn dance, Godwin met and later married Alice Maves on October 7, 1972 in Waupaca. He worked at Georgia-Pacific Corp. 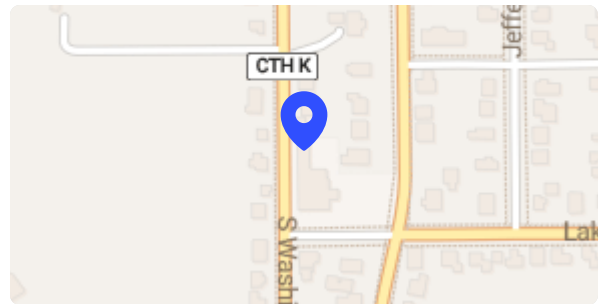

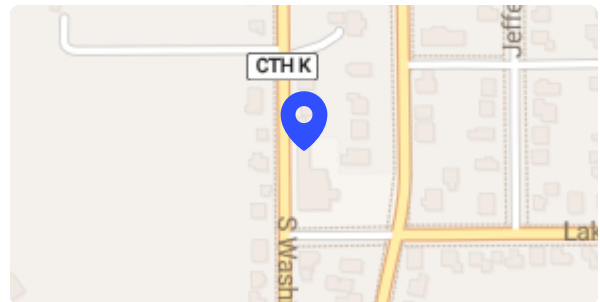

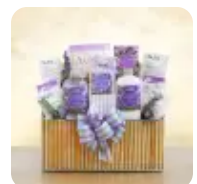
