**W**ayne C. Klein, II, age 93, of Waupaca, WI passed away on Tuesday, March 7, 2017 at Theda Care Medical Center-Waupaca.

Wayne was born in Superior, WI on July 11, 1923, the son of the late Wayne and Helen (Johnson) Klein Sr. Wayne's military career spanned 43 years in the US Army retiring as a Lieutenant Colonel. He proudly served in Europe during WW II in the 66th (Panther) Division, US Army and remained active with the veterans that he served with. He married Annette Mercier, a French Army translator he met while they were on duty in Vienna, Austria after the war ended and had 5 children. On March 3, 1970, Wayne married Phyllis Rice in Lyme Regis, England. He was an active member of Immanuel Evangelical Lutheran Church, Waupaca.
