She was born June 30, 1921 in Elcho, WI; daughter of Lewis and Olga (Olson) Kolden. Lori graduated from Amherst High School and Hollywood Beauty School in Appleton. She married Harlan Anderson in 1939 in Nelsonville and they had a son together, Darrell, and they both preceded her in death. Lori then went to Miami, FL where she owned and operated her own beauty salon. She married John Rumpf in 1955 and he preceded her in death in February 1973. After 21 years in Florida, she returned to Wisconsin and made Waupaca her home. She worked at Vernae’s Beauty Salon until her retirement.
