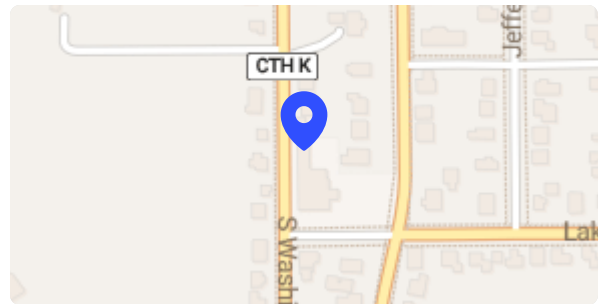
Doris was preceded in death by her parents Albert and Mary Toddish; her husband Delbert Hooey; three grandchildren; four sisters, and three brothers.

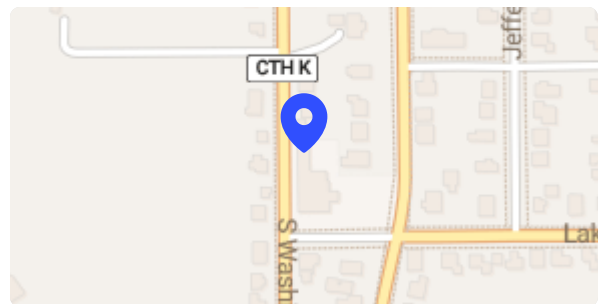
