Elaine graduated from Meadow Grove School in 1946. She was confirmed at St. John's Lutheran Church in Deer Creek in 1946. She attended and graduated from Clintonville High School in 1950. After graduation, Elaine worked at JCPenney and then at the Hansen Glove Factory in the inspection and shipping department.

Elaine married Ralph E. Allar, Jr on February 3, 1951 and they were married for 56 years before he preceded her in death. They had the kind of marriage that most people can only hope for and their love continued even after he passed away. Her heart remained with him until the day she passed and she was able to be with him again in Heaven. They lived in Bear Creek until March of 1954 when they moved to their current home in Waupaca. 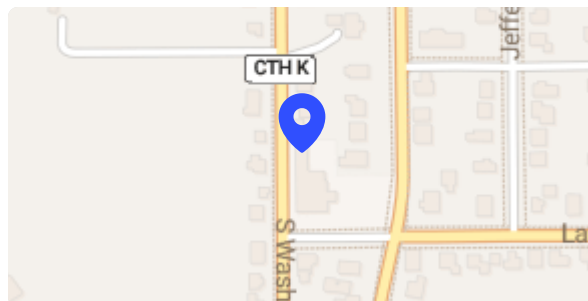
