In lieu of flowers the family will be accepting contributions to a memorial scholarship to be started at a later date.

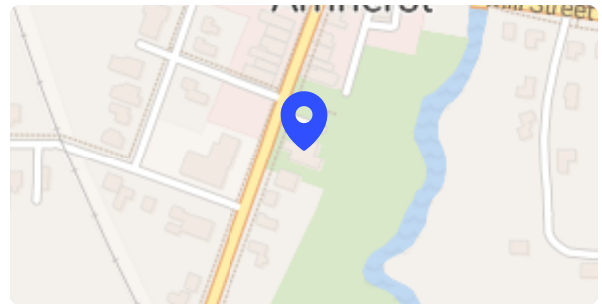

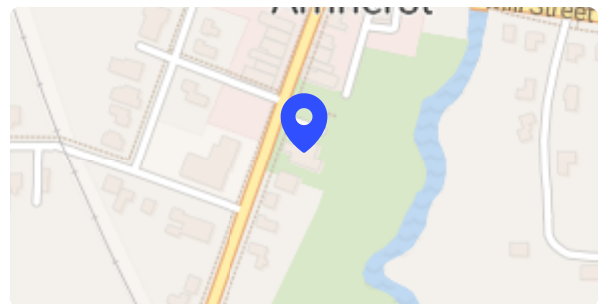

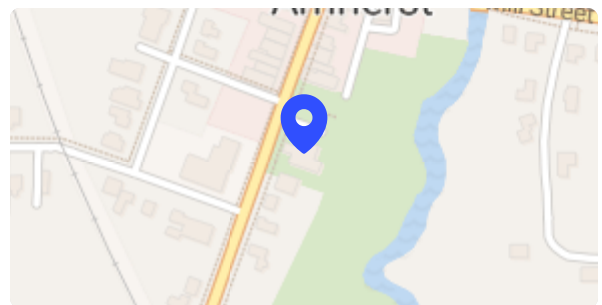
