Lee G. Bergman, age 90, of Nelsonville, WI, passed away peacefully on Friday, February 24, 2023 at his home with his loving family by his side. He was born on June 26, 1932 in Appleton, WI, son of Walter and Vivian (Skinner) Bergman. On June 27, 1953, he married the love of his life Dorothy “Linde” Lindquist at Trinity Lutheran Church in Appleton. They have been happily married for 69 years. Following high school, he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force from 1949 to 1953. Lee thoroughly enjoyed flying and working with planes, and later became a mechanic and a crew chief. He loved his time in the service, but especially experiencing one of the first flights over the North Pole in a B29 out of Fairbanks, Alaska. Lee spent 11 years as a fireman at the Appleton Fire Department, and another 10 years as an over the road truck driver for Gateway Trucking. Following this, he worked for the Portage County Parks Department as a park supervisor as well as a game warden until the time of his retirement. Among his favorite activities were fishing, playing cribbage, and watching the Packers every Sunday. Lee enjoyed feeding the birds regularly and was an avid bird watcher. He especially liked to watch and record the orioles that arrived every spring, and faithfully kept track of their migration. During their retirement years, Lee and Linde traveled to Florida and stayed there for six months until spring.
