Rebecca (Becky) Lynn Creamer, of Waupaca, Wisconsin, passed away peacefully at her family home on August 16, 2025, surrounded by loved ones.

Born on January 17, 1949, in Pontiac, Michigan, Becky moved with her family to Manawa, Wisconsin, shortly after birth. She grew up there and graduated from Little Wolf High School with the Class of 1967. On July 8, 1972, she married the love of her life, Doug Creamer.

Early in their marriage, Becky worked as a CNA at the Wisconsin Veterans Home. After starting her own family, she opened her heart and home to many children as a caretaker.
