Alan Daniel Thompson, age 61, entered eternity on August 22, 2025.

Al was born on June 12, 1964, the youngest son of Bob and Grace (née Goldsmith) Thompson. 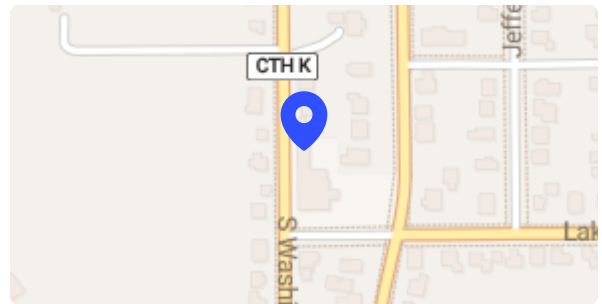

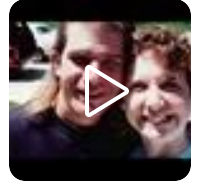
